DURING NIGHT OF
May 31st to June 1st, and
Forenoon of June 1st, 1916.

BATTLE FLEET.

During night, Battle Fleet in 3 columns, 1 mile apart, disposed abeam.

From 2.45 A. M. to 3.30 A. M., in single line.

From 3.30 A. M. onward, in 8 columns, 1 mile apart, disposed abeam.

POSITIONS OF CRUISERS ETC.

Dublin at 4.30 A. M. in Lat. $55^{\circ}30' N.$, Long. $6^{\circ}30' E.$

Commodore of Flotillas at S. O. A. M. in Lat. $55^{\circ}48' N.$, Long. $6^{\circ}22' E.$

Vice Admiral 1st Battle Squadron with 8th Division at S. O. A. M. in Lat. $55^{\circ}56' N.$, Long. $5^{\circ}15' E.$ steering S. S. E. 16 knots.

3 Submarines off Vyl Light Ship on bearing 270, 4 miles, 12 miles and 20 miles respectively from Lightship.
